His mom might weigh 100 lbs. soaking wet and her daily labor of love in caring for her son was made more difficult in the fact she had to pick her son up just to get him in and out of the house. Building them a simple wheelchair ramp seemed a very small thing to do given these circumstances.

When Eli's dad brought him out of the house to see what we had done, that child lit up like a Christmas tree! He immediately wanted to try out his new ramp. As we were picking up our tools, I asked Eli if he wanted to race me down the ramp. You would have thought I was inviting him to the Super Bowl. "Race? Sure! Wait right there until I get up there!" His dad brought him to the top then after a quick "Ready, Set, Go" the contest was on. (He beat me to the bottom but I still maintain he cheated!) J

This final scene and how it all came about reminded me why we do what we do. I had received a call from someone who attends one of our smallest churches informing me of this need. Another church volunteered to take the lead and with a donation here, another one there, the project was paid for and completed in short order. We had a great time working together and a young man and his family benefited greatly.

Reminds me of the elderly couple who were both blind in Longview, Mississippi after Katrina...

Reminds me of the Hispanic family in Vilonia, Arkansas who had been hit by "two" tornadoes in consecutive years...

Reminds me of the man in Malden, Missouri after a huge ice storm that had been sent home from the hospital for Hospice care that gave his heart to Jesus after we helped his family...

Reminds me of the countless volunteers who travel great distances, sacrifice being away from home, sleep on air mattresses, etc. all with joy in their heart as they help others...

I'm grateful that God allows me work alongside others who know the reason we do this thing called missions. I'm grateful I have an association that supports such efforts and isn't afraid to work together for a greater good; not caring who gets the credit.

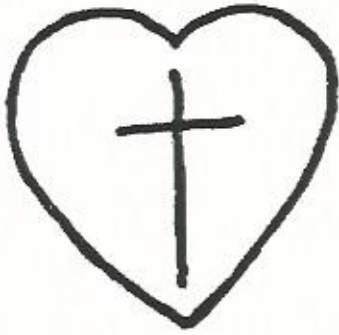

# DISCOVERY CLUB

What is Discovery Club?

It is a non-denominational after school Bible program taking the hope of the Gospel to elementary children in our public schools.

Where and when does it meet?

Clubs meet in elementary schools for one hour after school once a week for 23 weeks.

Is Discovery Club legal?

Yes. A 2001 U.S. Supreme Court ruling allowed for public school principals to invite any organization into the school building after regular hours.

How many schools now have Discovery Club?

There are 38 schools in Alabama and 3 schools in Columbia, TN.

How can volunteers participate?

- Become a teacher or mentor for an hour and a half each week
- Pray for this ministry
- Invite us to your church or organization to present this opportunity to volunteer others
- Take a love offering to help cover expenses
